Auditions for The Miss Firecracker Contest



Auditions for *The Miss Firecracker Contest,* a comedy by Beth Henley, will be held at CCT on **March 23 & 24**

(Monday & Tuesday) at 7PM.

The characters include:

- **Carnelle** (known locally as "Miss Hot Tamale") who hopes that winning the local Fourth of July pageant will salvage her tarnished reputation and allow her to leave town in a blaze of glory
- Carnelle's cousin **Elain**, a former Miss Firecracker winner, who has walked out on her rich-but-boring husband and her two small children
- Elain's eccentric brother, **Delmount**, recently released from a mental institution
- A touchingly awkward seamstress, named **Popeye**, who is hopelessly smitten by Delmount
- And several other complex and quirky characters

The cast includes four women, age 24-32, and two men, age 28 and 36. (Some flexibility is possible.) The show will open May 8 and run for three weekends.
